

**Registration for Cayuga's 150<sup>th</sup> Floral Competition

Registration forms for beautification projects connected with Cayuga's 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary are now available. In order to be included in the competition, flowers and others accessories must be in red, white, and blue, the colours of the Union Jack which was the country's flag in 1859 when the incorporation of the village took place.

Since there are few truly blue flowers, the committee will also accept deep bluish purple blooms similar to those that were used to decorate the village in the spring and summer of 2008.

The entrance categories are Victorian, Agricultural, Humorous, Modern, and Child's Garden. There is a registration fee of \$10 for each entry. A cheque in the appropriate amount for registration must accompany the form when it is submitted.

The type of areas to be judged include private residences, vehicles in an RV park, business premises, service clubs, churches and/or church halls, parks or public spaces, and sports facilities. If the location is different from

any of these sites, applicants may indicate that on the registration form.

Registration forms must be completed by June 30, 2009, and turned in to Grand Treats and Treasures/Sears in the Village Centre on Cayuga Street, on or before that date. Depending on the numbers of entries and weather conditions judging will take place the week of July 5<sup>th</sup> and winners will be announced Sunday, July 12<sup>th</sup>, at ceremonies on the Village Green.

Registration forms may be obtained from Grand Treats and Treasures/Sears, Kinnear Greenhouses and Gardens, Stephans V&S, VillEdge Garden Market, and the 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Office opening March 1st, at the corner of Cayuga Street and Highway 3 [formerly Rebound Fitness].
